Dear Parents and Students,

On the reverse side of this sheet is the list of titles for the Summer Reading Program. The main points of the program are outlined below.

- 1) The Summer Reading Program includes only rising 9-12 graders enrolled in college-prep English courses.
- 2) Each student is required to read the two books listed.
- 3) An objective test will be given the second day of school on the content of the assigned books. The score on this test will be counted fully in the course grade.
- 4) These books were chosen because they supplement the English curriculum. These books serve as important background reading for our English classes.
- 5) The books are listed according to English classes NOT according to grade level. Thus everyone going into LA 1000 will use the same list regardless of what grade he is in.

These books are all available locally. They can be borrowed from our public libraries.
